Church Night Supper Returns!

Church Night Suppers will resume Wednesday, April 7, at 5:45 p.m. and will continue through May 19. The cost, for the time being, will remain the same as previously: \$5.00 per person with a \$20.00 family limit. However, we are implementing some VERY IMPORTANT CHANGES:

- 1. Reservations MUST be made by 12:00 noon on the Monday before the supper. You may pay for your reservation(s) at the door or online—either way, you MUST PAY before you eat. Walk-ins on Wednesday nights will be asked to WAIT until everyone who has made a reservation is served.
- 2. Standing reservations may be made on a MONTHLY basis and MUST be paid for IN ADVANCE. You may pay in advance by check when you make your reservations or online.
- 3. If you have a reservation (standing or weekly) and do not keep it but have paid in advance, you will NOT receive a credit or a refund.
- 4. If you have a weekly reservation for which you have not paid and do not keep it, you WILL be billed for the cost.

These changes are necessitated by the number of people who make reservations but do not keep them and the number of people who eat without paying. Food quantities are based on the number of reservations, and unkept reservations mean food is wasted. Meals unpaid for mean less money to pay our costs. CNS is not included in the church budget, and while
