The church year is divided into seven "seasons", each having a special color and symbols. The practice of dividing the year into "seasons" is ancient, beginning early in the Church's history. The current "season" is Pentecost, commemorating the descent of the Holy Spirit, and the birth of the church, fifty days after the Resurrection. Red is the color of this season reminding us of the "cloven tongues of flame" appearing on the heads of those in the Upper Room (Acts 2:3). Symbols celebrating Pentecost include flames and especially the descending dove, symbol of the Holy Spirit. (Notice these symbols on the Altar table frontlet.)

We will celebrate the Pentecost season until Labor Day.
