Today we welcome our new Pastor, Rev. Mike Brown! We are so happy to have you!

The Reverend Michael T. "Mike" Brown was born May 31, 1959 (meaning he just turned 60), in Portsmouth, Virginia, the son of Larry and Jody Brown, Being part of a military family, Mike has lived in Virginia, Maryland, and California. He and his family moved to Albany, Georgia, in 1970, where his father retired from the Navy.

Mike is an honor graduate (5th in his class) of Dougherty High School in Albany (1977). He received an A.A. degree (Magna cum laude) from Truett-McConnell College (1979), a B.A. (Magna cum laude) from LaGrange College (1981), and a Master of Divinity degree from Duke University (1984).

Mike felt the call to ordained ministry in the summer between his freshman and sophomore years in college. He answered that call and was approved by the Charge Conference of his home church, Trinity United Methodist Church in Albany (now closed), certified as a candidate by the Thomasville District Committee on Ordained Ministry, approved as a probationary member and elected as a deacon by the South Georgia Annual Conference in 1983, and approved as a full conference member and elected as an elder in 1986.

Mike has completed 35 years of full-time ministry in the South Georgia Annual Conference. Added to that are two years as a student pastor while at LaGrange College, a year and a half as an assistant pastor in a church in the North Carolina Annual Conference, and a year and a half as a chaplain intern at The Methodist Retirement Home in Durham, North Carolina. During his 35 years in South Georgia, Mike has served in a number of leadership positions on the conference, district, and cluster levels.

Mike married Tammy Bishop of Commerce, Georgia, on July 4, 1981. They have two children. Allison, who was born September 14, 1988, is a 2007 graduate of Washington County High School and a 2011 graduate of Georgia Southern University, She married Tim Wall on November 11, 2017, and Tim and Allison live in Statesboro. Allison works for Bright from the Start. Michael was born July 8, 1991, is a 2009 graduate of Washington County High School and a 2013 graduate of Young Harris College. With a degree in theater, he hopes to pursue an acting career.
