The General Conference of The United Methodist Church (our denominational quadrennial meeting at which we make the laws of the church), originally scheduled for Spring 2020 and re-scheduled for late Summer 2021, has been postponed again until late Summer 2022. This postponement is due to concerns about the COVID-19 virus and about whether or not delegates from all over the world will have access to electronic media that would allow for a "virtual" meeting. The Council of Bishops has called a one-day session, set for May 8, for the sole purpose of "gaining a quorum in order to suspend the rules for the sole purpose of allowing the use of paper ballots to act upon 12 pieces of legislation that would enable the church to effectively continue its work until the postponed 2020 General Conference is held in 2022." In addition, "Special Sessions of the Jurisdictional Conferences to be held virtually in July 2021 (for the purpose of retiring bishops, announcing coverage of areas, and determining if or how many bishops will be elected in each Jurisdiction) and regular in-person Sessions of the Jurisdictional Conferences following the postponed 2020 General Conference in the Fall of 2022 (for the purpose of electing bishops, making assignments for the new quadrennium, electing members to General Boards/Agencies, etc.)."
